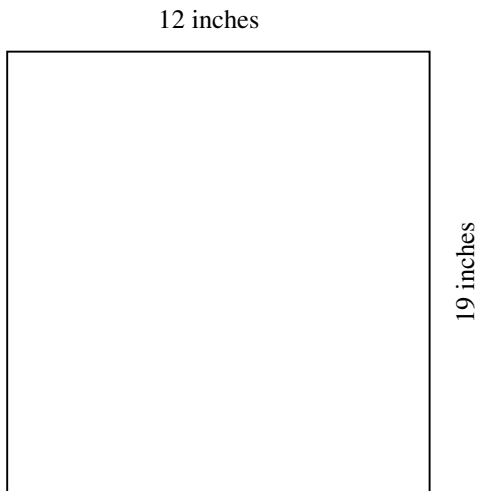


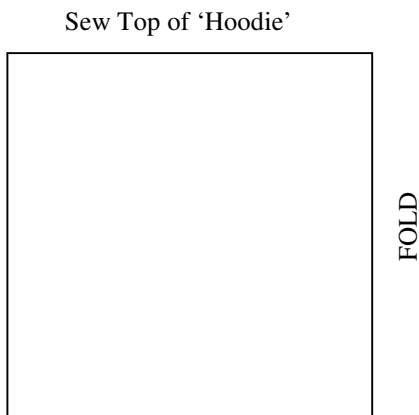
Scarf Hoodie

Materials:

- 12" wide x 19" long Fleece (black)
- Yarn of your choice (I used angora, handspun, hand dyed fingering weight)
- 1 K-crochet hook
- Tapestry Needle
- Sewing Machine
- Matching Yarn (for fleece – black)



1: Fold Material in half, Sew top of 'Hoodie'

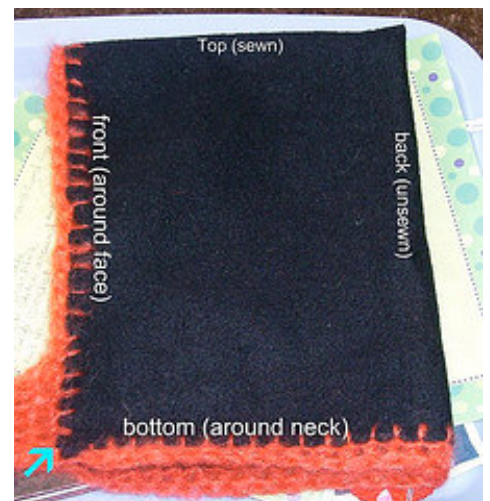


2: With tapestry Needle and yarn, Blanket Stitch around the 'face' and the 'bottom-neck'. (depending on fabric it might take a little effort) You might want to use an awl to pre-make holes.

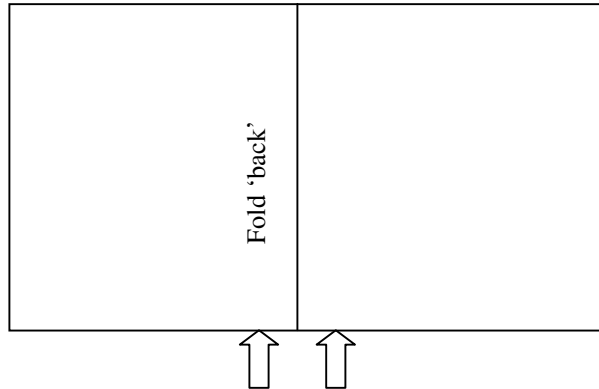

K hook, Yarn

3: Join with a slip stitch to Blanket stitch (blue arrow in picture), Single crochet in each stitch around.

4: Sc in each stitch in the 'bottom-neck', Dec sc 2 stitches before Middle and Dec sc 2 stitches After middle.



5: join with a slip stitch to bottom Right (see picture) [left] , single crochet across 7 stitches. Ch 1, turn



6: 1 single crochet in each stitch across (7sc), ch 1 turn

7: Repeat 38 more times (total 40 Rows)

8: Repeat for the [left] side

9: Weave in any loose ends.
